### **Franklin County Fair Horse Show Rules:**

**The Franklin County Agricultural Society mandates that all horses have their Rabies Shots and Negative Coggins Test.**

**No entries will be accepted without RABIES certificate for the current year a valid NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST (this test must be in the calendar year for 2009 or 2010 at the time of entry), as required by NYS Law.**

**All entries must include a copy of the negative Coggins and Rabies Certificate.**

**Any horse scratched must have a vet certificate in order to be refunded entry fees.**

**Each person that visits your fair is entitled to view all exhibits. A strong showing by exhibitors creates interest and builds a better fair.**

**Since the Department of Agriculture and markets is responsible for reimbursements of certain premiums, we have responsibility to regulate exhibits receiving these premiums.**

**Any exhibits arriving late, or removed early without approval, will not be eligible to receive their premium money.**

**All exhibitors must keep area clean.**

**Horses and Ponies entered in three (3) classes will be assigned stalls.**

**Horses not showing are not allowed a stall in the saddle horse or draft horse barn, and must leave the grounds.**

**There will be no dogs allowed on the grounds during fair week.**

**There will be no horses allowed on cross ties during fair week.**

**All trunks must be in tack stalls.**

**There will be no changing stalls after they have been assigned. Tack stalls not assigned until all stabling of animals is done. All stalls will be assigned by superintendents.**

### **ENTRIES:**

Entries may be made by mail, or the secretary will receive entries at the fair grounds office. The office will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding weekends. Mail Entries to: Franklin County Agricultural Society, Box 121, Malone, New York 12953. Payment must be accompanying all entries sent by mail. Copies of Coggins Test, Rabies Certificate and Registration Papers for breed class must be sent in with the entries mailed in.

### **CLOSING ENTRIES:**

Entries can not be made after the closing date except in case of emergency, and then only at the discretion of the Superintendents of the department concerned. Entries close in all departments on Friday July 23<sup>rd</sup>. After closing date entry fees will be double!

### **POST ENTRIES:**

(Except pair class) Entry fee will cost double. All entries will be made with the show secretary. Entries will not be taken over the phone. No post entries will be taken for a session, once the session starts.

### **PASSES:**

Horse exhibitors must purchase their passes when making their entries. The cost is \$10.00 per pass which is good for one exhibitor to the grounds per day and parking for the vehicle. All exhibitors must ride in at least three (3) classes to be eligible for a pass.

All animals in section 1 & 2 showing English and Western must be on the grounds by 8:00 a.m. Monday August 9<sup>th</sup>. The animals must remain until 5:00 p.m. Sunday August 15<sup>th</sup>.

Horses and Ponies showing only in the Western Division are allowed to check in by 10:00 a.m. Wednesday August 11<sup>th</sup>, and to remain until 5:00 p.m. Sunday August 15<sup>th</sup>. No outside horse allowed in the barns until the Friday preceding the fair at 10:00 a.m.

Horses entered in classes 20, 32, 63, & 93 must be registered with the Appaloosa Horse Club and must show papers.

Horses entered in the classes 14, 18, 35, 49, 83, & 94 must be registered with the American Quarter Horse Association and must show papers.

Horse entered in classes 19, 36, 59, & 85 must be registered with the American paint Horse Association and must show papers.

Horses entered in any classes of Non-Registered must not be registered with any breed association or club recognized by the American Horse Association. Registered or Non-Registered horses may enter open division classes.

The only time exhibitors may show off trailers is Monday, English Day. Horse shown any other time during the fair must be entered in three (3) classes.

No one will be allowed to park a trailer on the grounds Monday, English Day, if they have a stall assigned for the rest of the week.

All youth entered in the Franklin County Fair Horse Show must wear a properly fitted and secured, officially approved protective helmet at all times when mounted on an equine. This is required for all youth 18 years of age or younger, except halter class, and showmanship.

No one will be admitted to a class once the gate is closed. Inform the ring master of any tack changes. Reasonable time will be allowed.

4-H Exhibitors requesting over night stalls will be stabled in the draft horse barn, and will be asked to clean area used, and leave after the 4-H Show, Sunday August 8<sup>th</sup>.

4-H Exhibitors requesting stalls in the main barn or draft barn and entering the open horse show, showing English & Western must stay all week and remain until designated time to leave, which is August 15<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m.

There will be no substitute of horse or switching of classes. Horses entered in the fair must participate in the horse show.

Premiums will be held by the horse superintendent, should there be any unnecessary fraternization between the exhibitor and the judges, during the show.

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR NOVICE CLASSES**

Open to riders who have won 5 or fewer Blue Ribbons in under saddle classes prior to the current year. Blues in Leadline, Walk-Trot and 4-H Danish System do not count.

**PATTERN FOR CLASS 43 AND CLASS 44 (SECTION D THURSDAY)**

- 1. Enter at a jog.**
- 2. Continue to jog a small circle to the right.**
- 3. Close the circle and jog a small circle to the left.**
- 4. Continue jog and jog to the center of the ring and stop.**
- 5. Do a quarter turn to the right.**
- 6. Lope a large circle to the right.**
- 7. At the center of the ring do a simple change to the left lead.**
- 8. Lope a large circle to the left.**
- 9. At the center continue on the left lead arcing to the west fence.**
- 10. Stop and do a roll back to the right.**
- 11. Do a half circle on the right lead arcing back to the west fence.**
- 12. Stop and do a roll back to the left.**
- 13. Lope on left lead down the south fence.**
- 14. Stop and back at least 10 feet.**
- 15. Stop and wait to be dismissed.**

## **PATTERN FOR CLASS 67 AND 68 (SECTION F FRIDAY)**

- 1. Walk to the center of the ring**
- 2. Starting on the right lead lope a circle to the right.**
- 3. At the center of the ring do a simple lead change.**
- 4. Lope a circle to the left.**
- 5. As the circle is closed continue loping in a straight line.**
- 6. Stop.**
- 7. Do a turn on the haunches to the left.**
- 8. Lope on the left lead past the center of the ring.**
- 9. Stop.**
- 10. Do a turn on the haunches to the right.**
- 11. Lope on the right lead to the center of the ring.**
- 12. Stop.**
- 13. Do a ¼ turn to the right.**
- 14. Jog a small circle to the right.**
- 15. Jog a small circle to the left.**
- 16. Continue jogging in a straight line to the judge.**
- 17. Stop and back up.**
- 18. When excused turn and leave the ring at a trot.**

### Chester Sutton Memorial Award

This award is presented to the winner of Class 58, Open Pleasure. Chester was a husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather who enjoyed many years watching his grandchild and great-children compete. He rarely missed a show and Western Pleasure Classes were his particular favorite. His familiar face will be missed. This award is presented by the Sutton Family in his memory and his honor.

### Class 64 Versatility Horse Rider 18 & Under Little Navajo Fury Memorial Versatility Award.

This award is presented by Maple Ridge Farm in memory of Little Navajo Fury, aka "HOJ" competed at the Franklin County Fair for 25 consecutive years, last showing in 2001 at the age of 28 when he carried his youth riders to reserve championship. He did anything and everything asked of him and reliably carried many different riders to wins in many different classes. This award is given in his honor and his memory.

**The OH Wild Doc Triple Challenge Trophy.**

**This trophy is presented to the winner of Class 71 Western Horsemanship 14 -18 in honor of OH Wild Doc. Doc was shown 13 years at the Franklin County Fair until age 18, and each year he won a Grand or Reserve Championship. Doc was also an outstanding pattern horse and excelled in the Horsemanship and equitation classes as well as Western Pleasure and Trail. Doc won the Western Horsemanship 14 – 18 class at the Franklin County Fair many years in a row and continues his success in the 19 & Over Division. He is an amazing horse and had a lot of heart. He is now enjoying retirement on green pastures and is very happy. This trophy is presented to the winner of the Western Horsemanship 14 -18 class, and should the same rider win the trophy 3 years in a row, it will be retired to that rider.
