1. Competition is open to Franklin County Residents.
2. Pre-entry in all departments is required. Entry forms are available at the Fair Office or call 483-0720, or on our website at frcofair.com.
3. **Entry Forms are due on or before July 16, 2010**
4. All entries in Department F must be clearly tagged and ready for display according to the rules. **Entries not tagged properly are subject to disqualification.**
5. All exhibits must remain in place until Monday following the Fair and may be picked up between 8 A.M. and 11 A.M on that day.
6. Vegetable hall will be open from approximately 9 A.M. until 9 P.M. daily, except when judging is in progress.
7. Entry fee is 10% of first premium.
8. No articles shall be exhibited for more than one (1) premium.
9. Canned Goods previously exhibited at the Fair cannot be entered more than one (1) year for premium money. They will be disqualified if entered the following year.
10. Each exhibitor will be allowed one (1) entry per class unless where noted.
11. Elimination will be made on the basis of appearance, final selection on quality and taste. **Judges will open canned goods, only if they feel it is absolutely necessary. Baked goods will be cut and tasted.**  
**ALL MUST BE CLEARLY LABELED AND DATED WITH MONTH AND YEAR OR WILL BE DISQUALIFIED**

**\*\*All rings must be left on canned goods, or they are subject to disqualification\*\***

12. Classes in each section are numbered and premiums will be awarded to their rank as first, second, and third.

**\*\*All preserved food should be exhibited in standard containers and must be canned within the year. Standard containers refer to glass jars. The size of the jar is to be specified in each class. All canned goods must be properly sealed to preserve the product.**

**Please note: Premium checks will be issued on Monday following the fair when your exhibits are picked up.**

**Standards for canned fruits and vegetables:**

**Color:** As near as possible to the natural fruit or vegetable

**Clearness:** Syrup or liquid clear

**Date must be on label**

**Pack:** Arrangement with preference to symmetry and best use of space. As large a portion of solid and liquid as possible, Uniformity of shape and size

**Containers: ONLY JARS WITH STANDARD 2 PIECE LIDS –NO RUBBER RING SETS WILL BE ALLOWED, ALL OTHER WILL BE DISQUALIFIED**

**Texture:** Tender but not overcooked, uniformly ripened product, no defective or overripe fruits and vegetables. Only young and tender vegetables should be canned.

**Texture of marmalades:** Small clear pieces of fruit in a clear, soft jelly

**Flavor:** Natural fruit flavor preserved, just the right sweetness

2. No prize will be awarded in the opinion of the judge, that an article is deemed unworthy.

3. All baked goods must remain in place until Monday after the Fair closes. **Articles must be picked up on Monday by 11 A.M.**

4. No pre-mix allowed **\*\*Exception, decorated cakes\*\***

5. Standards for yeast breads: size: about 9x4 inches, shape: oblong, uniform height in all parts, crumb, well raised, equally light throughout, absence of heavy spots or streaks, tender but not crumbly, fine even grained, elastic when pressed, crust uniform, golden brown, crisp and smooth, flavor sweet with no suggestion of sourness, or taste of yeast.
