Current Coggins and rabies certificate required. Will be checked before animals are unloaded.

ASTM properly secured helmets are required to be worn by all youth ages 18 and under at all times on the fairgrounds while exhibiting in hand or riding or driving in any vehicle being pulled by an equine or donkey.

\$ 4.00 per youth in all classes. \$5.00 per adult per class entry fee

\$ 5.00 Office fee per animal/handler/rider fee unless a paid member of NAMED. No office fee for member.

Rules used will be American Miniature Horse Association rules except for height requirements and addition of "small pony" riding classes.

No horse/pony/donkey association registration required.

Miniature horses and donkeys will be 48 inches and under. All animals will be officially measured the day of the show unless they have an official AMHA card with official height. Measurement will be taken at the last true hair of the mane.

*Please note this is an exhibition show. Future shows will have Class A, Class B and Small Show Pony and Donkey divisions.

Trailer parking area will be designated by Fair Personnel. No parking, driving or riding on racetrack or in car parking areas.

Fr. County Fair Ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Plus- Some great awards will be given in sponsored classes! If you would like to sponsor a class award, contact Amanda Banker.

Pattern Books will be available day of show. Patterns will also be posted at ringside.

Youth Grand and Reserve Champion Award- All youth and open classes to count with the exception of the Small Pony Pleasure and Equitation and Leadline.

Adult Grand and Reserve Champion Award- All adult and open classes to count.

Youth age is 18 and under as of January 1.

All animals must have a current Coggins and rabies certificate submitted with their entry form.

Classes will run as listed in entry.

Tack changes must be requested 2 classes in advance. 3 minute gate call only.

Youth drivers 14 and under may have adult assistant in the cart with them.
Drivers may have grooms at the end of each driving class.

Youth or adults with developmental or physical limitations may have adaptive equipment and an adult assistant present in the ring as needed. Request prior to show start.

All judge's decisions are final.

Management reserves the right to make changes as needed to schedule to accommodate time constrictions. Show must be completed before Tractor Pull traffic becomes an issue.
